- 1. Primary colors are called primary because they cannot be mixed from other colors.
- 2. Secondary colors are mixed from two primaries.
- 3. Tertiary colors exist between secondary and primary colors
- 4. Only two primaries are used to keep a clear color. When three primaries are present, the color is muddy. Three primaries can make black.

VOCABULARY WORDS: COLOR WHEEL

Primary color: A color that cannot be mixed from other colors

Secondary color: A mixture between two primary colors

Tertiary color: A mixture between a secondary and a primary color

Adjusted color: Any color that contains three primary colors

Complimentary color: Colors opposite each other on the color wheel

Tint: A color mixed with white

Analogous Colors: These colors close to each other on the color wheel.
