

Instructions: Color Wheel

1. Using anything round, such as a lid about 8 inches in diameter, trace around the lid onto light paper. Cut out the circle and fold it twice, making quarters.
2. Outline the circle into your process journals or a piece of watercolor paper, marking where the quarters are.
3. Add two additional sections in each quarter. With a ruler, draw lines through the center of the circle creating a wheel of 12 equal sections.
4. Use three primary colors to mix three secondary and six tertiary colors, make a color wheel.
5. Make the steps between the colors in equal steps as much as you can.
6. The color wheel should be placed in your research notebooks and annotated using the project concepts
