## **Instructions: Color Wheel**

- 1. Using anything round, such as a lid about 8 inches in diameter, trace around the lid onto light paper. Cut out the circle and fold it twice, making quarters.
- 2. Outline the circle into your process journals or a piece of watercolor paper, marking where the quarters are.
- 3. Add two additional sections in each quarter. With a ruler, draw lines through the center of the circle creating a wheel of 12 equal sections.
- 4. Use three primary colors to mix three secondary and six tertiary colors, make a color wheel.
- 5. Make the steps between the colors in equal steps as much as you can.
- 6. The color wheel should be placed in your research notebooks and annotated using the project concepts



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
