## RUBRIC: Drawing with Four Kinds of Lines

Process journal contains three pages of vignette drawings of simple objects.

Student composes at least one still life with three or more objects.

The proportions of the different parts of each object are drawn correctly.

The objects are accurately placed within the composition.

The value shapes are accurate and show skill in rendering.

There is marked improvement in the final drawings compared to the first ones.

Drawings are annotated using unit vocabulary words.

The drawings are developed and show the use of contour and surface lines (and evidence of structural lines).

Proportions of the objects appear distorted.

The objects within the composition are not accurately placed.

The student does not use different line types correctly Deadlines are not met.
