

Rubric for Pen and Ink: Drawing Animals

A-B

Student researches pen and ink tutorials on YouTube and/or uses the worksheets posted on this site to complete two pages of pen and ink practice in research journal.

Student posts three pages of drawings based on photocopied images of animals researched from the internet or from a book

The animal images used as subjects are posted next to the student's drawings.

The student uses hatching cross hatching and any other technique he researches in the animal studies.

The animals are drawn with correct proportions and the pen and ink work is effective in creating the textures on the animal's body. The student's drawing has a Strong resemblance to the model, although there is some artistic license allowed.

There is an improvement between the first drawings and the last.
Deadlines are met and journal pages are dated and numbered.

C-F

Student does not do any of his own research.

The practice work is not completed or it is of poor quality, lines uneven and messy.

Student does not complete animal research and/or does not complete three drawings of animals

The student does not post the images he uses next to his drawings.

The hatching and cross hatching is messy and disorganized.

The animal drawing is not accurate and the student fails to develop a texture on the surface of the drawing that resembles the model

The drawing is not accurately done.

There is little improvement from the beginning drawings to the final ones.
Deadlines are not met
The journal pages are not numbered and dated.
