



Identity Collage

DIRECTIONS:

1. To create a collage based on personal identity, students will need many different kinds of paper. Below are some possibilities for papers to use in the collage.
 - a. Old report cards
 - b. Maps
 - c. Letters
 - d. Photocopies of official documents like passports or birth certificates
 - e. Images from magazines
 - f. Photocopies of family pictures, school pictures, gift wrap, tissue paper, newspaper, pages from books
2. It is a good idea to make copies of images so they can be combined in several different provisional compositions.
3. Do research on collages. You can find your own research, but here are three suggestions.
