

ASSIGNMENT: ABSTRACT SELF PORTRAIT

Begin to research the styles of other artists. Find a style of working that you would like to use for your own work. This could be in Picasso's cubist style, like Marc Chagall, or any artist that you admire.

Below is a list of artists to check out, but you can find your own artists as well. These should be researched in your research notebook. Remember, this research should be based on what you need to know to understand the way these artists work, their time in history, their unique contributions.

Be sure to include medium experiments in your research notebooks based on their style.
